

WHAT ARE SAGE PRINTER ERRORS?

Sage printer inactive error indicates when the user is attempting to email, or print forms and reports the error message is displayed. During the error scenario the Sage 50 US edition closes while the user tries to emails or prints forms and reports. It gives an error message like: “Printer not activated error 20” “Printer not activated error 30” “Printer not activated error 41”

CAUSES OF SAGE PRINTER ERRORS

Causes responsible for the occurrence of the Sage Printer Errors

- User Account Control (UAC) enabled
- Incompatibility of the email program
- Damaged Windows Profile
- Installation of the Microsoft updates need to be done
- Damaged E-mail Writer
- The customized forms are damaged
- Attempting to use Sage 50 E-mail writer as a printer
- Settings on Sage 50 E-mail Writer are improper

Solutions to Fix Sage Printer Errors

You can use the following ways to fix the errors while printing forms in the Sage Software:

- If the pop-up is displayed when accessing a saved print file, recreate the file after completing the above actions.
- Confirm that the check stock is loaded into the proper tray in the printer.
- If checks are loaded into the manual tray they may not print properly.
- Use the ping order to confirm that the network printer is now available and fully accessible via a network connection.
- Access Crystal Report margins from Print Preview using the Page Setup button in the top left.
